The Audio Visual Ministry strives “To glorify God by ensuring that His Word, our prayer and songs of praise to Him are seen and heard clearly.”

Audio Visual Ministers operate the equipment in the AV room during Mass in the Serra Center. A power point presentation is provided for the AV minister to display and to ensure the congregation is able to follow during Mass. The AV minister makes slight adjustment to sound levels during Mass. On occasions, during special Masses, like Baptisms, we operate the camera that is projected on the screen in the Serra Center.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q. What about training?**
A. *Complete training on equipment is provided. No experience necessary, only the willingness to learn.*
- Q. Is it necessary to be certified by the Diocese?**
A. *Certification is not required.*
- Q. What is the time commitment?**
A. *You choose how many Masses you want to serve each month. You need to be available at least 30 minutes before Mass and about 10 minutes after Mass.*
- Q. When are members of this ministry most needed?**
A. *At all Masses in the Serra Center.*
