DEAR FRIENDS,

Peace and all Good!

I must admit that on every Sunday that today's gospel is presented, I am a bit embarrassed. Here I am in the front seat of the assembly, wearing robes, and being called father. As we read on in chapter 23 of St. Matthew, we see that Jesus is giving a full attack on the Pharisees and the Scribes who have been exhausting him all day in the Temple with their testing and tricking. Jesus is really giving a condemnation of hypocrisy—not the priesthood per se. If we were to admit it, we are all tempted by a variety of “tassels and titles”—power, wealth, fame, pleasure, independence. But Jesus calls us to live the virtue of humility—the virtue St. Francis prized above all others. “Praise and bless my Lord and give Him thanks and serve Him with great humility.” (Canticle of Brother Sun)

I call your attention to the Pastoral Council Discernment Workshop on November 14th. Many ask what is the role of the Parish Pastoral Council. I answer with a question: “How can the Council and our parishioners continue to carry out the mission of Christ?” In order to carry out the mission of Christ, the Council develops a parish plan and then oversees it. The goal of the Council is to focus attention on the pastoral needs of the parish, which will help us grow spiritually. Please see today's bulletin for more details. Thank you.

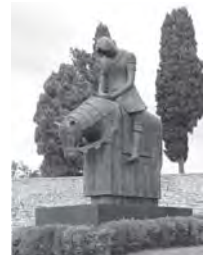
